2. Work Experience

Facilitator, Camphill Scotland

Camphill Scotland is the umbrella body for Camphill communities in Scotland. Camphill communities offer a shared living approach to support for people with a range of support needs, primarily those with a learning disability; different communities support individuals at different stages in their lives, with support being available across Scotland for everyone from children to older people.

In this role I provide policy advice to Camphill communities on a range of issues including, but by no means limited to, funding, commissioning, contracting, regulation, and self-directed support. I represent the views of Camphill communities on groups such as the ASD reference group by consulting with communities on the issues discussed.

Prior to starting with Camphill Scotland in January 2011, I worked for six years at CCPS, the national umbrella organisation for voluntary sector social care providers, where I developed expertise in policy areas such as funding, commissioning and regulation, and their impact on voluntary sector providers.
